#### *Peace and Security Committee*

1. Resolve the mandate of UN-intervention and UN-interposition in national conflicts
2. Agree on measures to combat internationally organized criminality
3. Agree on measures to protect women's rights and safety in a war situation

#### *Economic and Social Committee*

1. Agree on measures for dividing costs for ensuring action against climate change between countries in a fair way, in order to secure international climate deals
2. Agree on measures to assure that all countries have access to sufficient vaccine supplies to cover the needs within the population
